#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Support Technician is responsible for performing a variety of tasks to support the Head Start center and transportation staff. This position will perform bus monitor, custodial, nutrition and classroom duties as needed.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE POSITION** (If an individual is qualified to perform essential functions of the position, except for limitations caused by a disability, CAPSTJOE will consider whether the individual could perform these functions with a reasonable accommodation)

- 1. Follow agency procedures for pick-up and delivery of children on the bus
- 2. Observe and address needs of children on the bus and reports observations, actions to the appropriate staff
- 3. Prepare/serve family style meals and snacks according to established menus
- 4. Maintain nutrition documentation as outlined
- 5. Ensure Head Start Facilities are clean and free of debris
- 6. Provide support services to teachers in classroom setting
- 7. Establish and maintain a clean, safe, healthy, positive and comfortable learning environment
- 8. Model appropriate adult to child, adult to adult interactions/behavior. Support the social and emotional development of children along with demonstrating positive parent communication
